Bring original Coggins with you to the show grounds (Tennessee state law). Coggins test must be dated within 12 months of show date. You must show your original Coggins when picking up your entry packet.

Release **MUST** be signed.

Secretary must receive entries by the closing date. Post entries are solely at the discretion of the Secretary.

Ride times will be available on the DDA website 2-3 days prior to show date.

Helmet rules will be determined by the management of the hosting farm. Helmet rules will be posted at each show and must be complied with by all riders.

SHOW LOCATION: Massar Stables 1387 Orr Road, Arlington, TN 38002

Show will begin at approximately 8:00 a.m.

ARENAS: Standard 20m x 60m arena; surface is sand. Warm-up in indoor 20m x 40m arena with sandfooting.

Lunging available in round pen with sand footing and in grassy area.

Negative Coggins: within 12 months of show date. Bring original to show grounds (Tenn. State law *0082-201-0-3, effective 1/1/90). All horses brought onto grounds must present negative Coggins when picking up entry packet.

Post entries will be accepted at the discretion of Show Secretary.

Refunds: before closing date, with veterinary certificate, less a \$5.00 office fee. No refunds after closing date.

- Please leave dogs at home.
- Concessions will be available.
- Parking and lunging in designated areas only.
- Show will go on in most weather conditions. In case of severe weather, contact organizer for alternate plans.

Schedule: Call or e-mail secretary after Wednesday, March 25. If you indicate on your entry form, you may receive your ride times by e-mail 2-3 days before the show. In addition, ride times will be posted on DDA's website 2-3 days prior to show. www.deltadressage.com

Year-End Awards: Rides at this show count towards DDA Year-End Awards. See www.deltadressage.com for eligibility requirements.

DIRECTIONS TO MASSAR STABLES:

From I-40: Travel east from Memphis, take the Arlington Exit (#25) and go north (left) toward Arlington. Go approx. 1 mile, turn right on Hayes. Follow this until it dead-ends into Chester. Turn right on Chester and go a very short distance and turn left at Griffin. When this dead-ends, turn right on Forrest (which becomes Hickory Withe/196) Go approx. 3 miles until you go over an overpass of the interstate. As you reach the south side of the overpass, Orr Road is on the right side. Turn right on Orr Road, go approx. 1-1/2 mile - Massar Stables is on the left side - 1387 Orr Road.

From Highway 64: Travel east from Memphis, go approx. 3 miles past the Fayette County sign. Turn left (north) on Hickory Withe/196 N at the stop light. Go approx. 5 miles. As you go up toward the overpass of the interstate, Orr Road is on the left side. Turn left on Orr Rd, go approx. 1-1/2 mile - Massar Stable is on the left side - 1387 Orr Road.

From Highway 70 (in Arlington): Travel northeast on highway 70 into Arlington. Turn right (south) on Chester at the flashing light. Follow the road over the railroad tracks and to the right of the fork (left fork is one-way coming toward you). At the first intersection turn left (Forrest). Go approx. 3 miles until you go over the overpass of the interstate. On the south side of the overpass, turn right on Orr Road. Go 1-1/2 miles, Massar Stables is on the left - 1387 Orr Road.



GENERAL

1. Dress in conservative breeches, shirt with sleeves & collar (such as a “polo” shirt) and boots. Gloves of a conservative color are recommended. Headgear is required, either protective helmet or show helmet/hat according to level.
2. If a horse is ridden by more than one rider, separate entry forms should be used. Each rider will have a separate bridle number.
3. Refer to the USEF Rule Book for information including approved bits, whip lengths, etc.
4. If a horse gets loose on the ground, all riders should stop in place until the horse is caught. Please keep an eye on your horse if he is tied to the trailer.
5. Tests can be picked up from the designated area after the class has been placed & posted. Please do not bother scorers while they are working.
6. Be courteous to other exhibitors & volunteers and enjoy your show experience.

UPON ARRIVAL

1. Check in with the show secretary. Bring original Coggins Papers with you.
2. Wear bridle number at all times.

WARM-UP

1. Lunge horses in designated area. Ask show secretary or show manager if in question. Do not lunge in riding arena.
2. If possible, mount & dismount outside of arena.
3. Enter warm-up arena with caution. Horses in arena have “right of way”.
4. Maintain a safe distance (at least one horse length) between you and the horse in front of you. Keep your head up & watch where you are going. Horses in walk should use inner part of arena. Ride as you drive – left shoulder to left shoulder.
5. Keep track of your ride time. Check with paddock master & promptly proceed to competition arena when the horse ahead of you begins their test.
6. Remove leg wraps, splint boots and bell boots before entering competition arena.
7. Make sure your bridle number is visible to scribe as you walk by judge & scribe. You may want to announce your number as you ride by.
8. Warm up on the outside area of the arena until the bell or whistle is heard. You then have 45 seconds to enter and begin your test.
9. After your final salute, you may thank your judge. Occasionally at schooling shows, the judge may make comments or suggestions.
