*****IMPORTANT COMPETITOR INFORMATION*****

Bring original Coggins with you to the show grounds (Tennessee state law). Coggins test must be dated within 12 months of show date. *You must show your original Coggins when picking up your entry packet.* All horses entering grounds must pay grounds fee. Post entries are solely at the discretion of the Secretary.

Ride times will be posted www.deltadressage.com 2-3 days before the competition.

Helmet rules will be determined by the management of the hosting farm. Helmet rules will be posted at each show and must be complied with by all riders.
