**SHOW LOCATION: Fair Meadow Farm, 5610 Forest Hill-Irene Road, Memphis, TN 38125**

Show will begin at approximately 8:00 a.m.

ARENAS: Standard 20m x 60m arena; surface is sand. Warm-up in outdoor 20m x 40m arena with sand footing. Lunging available in grassy area (subject to weather-check with Sara)

Negative Coggins: within 12 months of show date. Bring original to show grounds (Tenn. State law \*0082-201-0-3, effective 1/1/90). All horses brought onto grounds must present negative Coggins when picking up entry packet. All horses entering grounds must pay grounds fee.

**FEES:**

\$20.00 per dressage test for DDA members  
\$25.00 per dressage test for non-members  
\$ 5.00 per horse grounds fee  
\$ 5.00 per horse in Arena Introduction  
Post entries discretion of Show Secretary.

Refunds: before closing date, with veterinary certificate, less a \$5.00 office fee. No refunds after closing date.

**AWARDS:**

Medal for 1st place, ribbons  
2nd - 6th place in each level.  
Jr/YR, A/A, & Open.

**Special Considerations:**

- Absolutely NO outside dogs.
- Concessions will be available.
- Parking and lunging in designated areas only.
- Show will go on in most weather conditions. In case of severe weather, contact organizer for alternate plans.

Schedule: Call or e-mail secretary after Wednesday, June 24. If you indicate on your entry form, you may receive your ride times by e-mail 2-3 days before the show. In addition, ride times will be posted on DDA's website 2-3 days prior to show. [www.deltadressage.com](http://www.deltadressage.com)

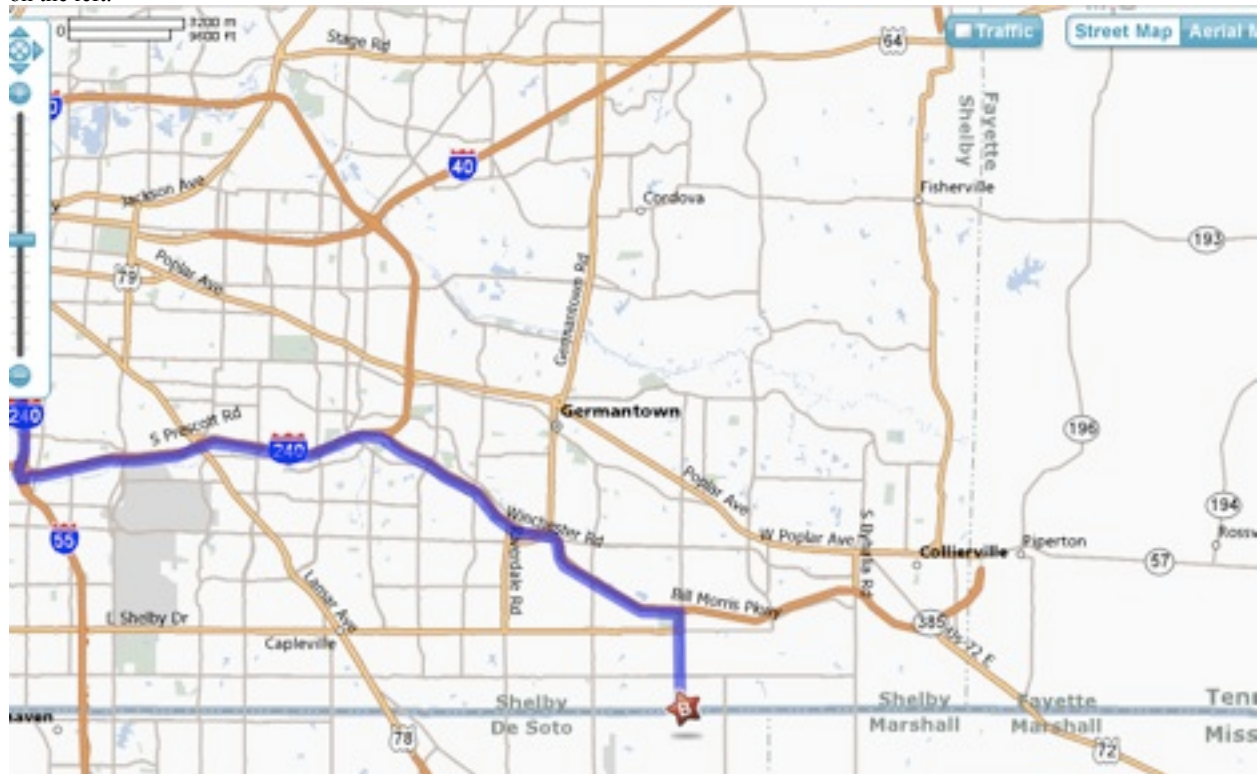

### Directions to Fair Meadow Farm.

From HWY 55 Mississippi, head North. Take the I240 exit going East (Towards Nashville, TN). Take the Bill Morris Parkway exit (a.k.a. Nonconnah) going East. You will pass Ridgeway, Kirby, Winchester, and Hack Cross exits. Take the Forest Hill-Irene exit heading South (Right Hand merge). Go all the way to the end of Forest Hill-Irene (It dead-ends). Fair Meadow Farm is the last property on the left.

From Fayette Co./Poplar Ave (HWY 57). Heading West on HWY 57, turn left onto Bill Morris Parkway. Take the Forest Hill-Irene exit heading South (Right Hand merge). Go all the way to the end of Forest Hill-Irene (It dead-ends). Fair Meadow Farm is the last property on the left.

From North, take I240 towards Nashville/Jackson, MS. Merge Right onto Bill Morris Parkway exit (just after the Poplar Avenue exit) going East. You will pass Ridgeway, Kirby, Winchester, and Hack Cross exits. Take the Forest Hill-Irene exit heading South (Right Hand merge). Go all the way to the end of Forest Hill-Irene (It dead-ends). Fair Meadow Farm is the last property on the left.

## GUIDELINES

### GENERAL

1. Dress in conservative breeches, shirt with sleeves & collar (such as a “polo” shirt) and boots. Gloves of a conservative color are recommended. Headgear is required, either protective helmet or show helmet/hat according to level.
2. If a horse is ridden by more than one rider, separate entry forms should be used. Each rider will have a separate bridle number.
3. Refer to the USEF Rule Book for information including approved bits, whip lengths, etc.
4. If a horse gets loose on the ground, all riders should stop in place until the horse is caught. Please keep an eye on your horse if he is tied to the trailer.
5. Tests can be picked up from the designated area after the class has been placed & posted. Please do not bother scorers while they are working.
6. Be courteous to other exhibitors & volunteers and enjoy your show experience.

### UPON ARRIVAL

1. Check in with the show secretary. Bring original Coggins Papers with you.
2. Wear bridle number at all times.

### WARM-UP

1. Lunge horses in designated area. Ask show secretary or show manager if in question. Do not lunge in riding arena.
2. If possible, mount & dismount outside of arena.
3. Enter warm-up arena with caution. Horses in arena have “right of way”.
4. Maintain a safe distance (at least one horse length) between you and the horse in front of you. Keep your head up & watch where you are going. Horses in walk should use inner part of arena. Ride as you drive – left shoulder to left shoulder.
5. Keep track of your ride time. Check with paddock master & promptly proceed to competition arena when the horse ahead of you begins their test.
6. Remove leg wraps, splint boots and bell boots before entering competition arena.
7. Make sure your bridle number is visible to scribe as you walk by judge & scribe. You may want to announce your number as you ride by.
8. Warm up on the outside area of the arena until the bell or whistle is heard. You then have 45 seconds to enter and begin your test.
9. After your final salute, you may thank your judge. Occasionally at schooling shows, the judge may make comments or suggestions.
